What to bring:

- 1. Attention students, please be informed that you may have to wait several days before receiving your first stipend. Therefore, it is recommended that you bring some cash (at least 600 USD) to cover your expenses.
- 2. Georgia experiences four seasons, so it is advisable to pack clothes suitable for all seasons. December, January, and February are the coldest in Tbilisi, with temperatures ranging from 3°C to 7°C. Meanwhile, October has an average temperature range of 13°C -22°C. If you plan to visit during July and August, be prepared for the hottest months, with temperatures ranging from 25°C to 40°C. Before traveling to Georgia, please check the weather in Tbilisi to ensure you bring appropriate clothing.
