

ONLINE COURSES IN ENGLISH

- Four Proficiency tests to measure the progress of the student's knowledge of the language throughout the course.

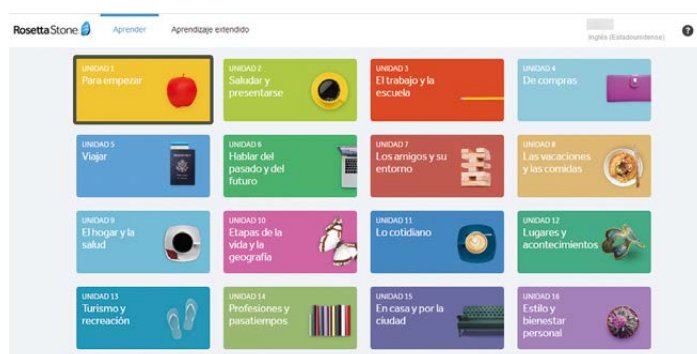
STUDY OPTIONS

CONTENT OF EACH LEVEL

BEGINNER LEVEL

A1 Understand and use the language at a basic level to satisfy immediate needs. Introduce yourself and others, ask for and give basic personal information about your home, your belongings, and people you know. Interact at the basic level as long as the speaker talks slowly and clearly, and is willing to cooperate.

A2 Understand and use the language at a basic level in areas of experience that are especially relevant to you (basic information about yourself and your family, shopping, places of interest, occupations, etc.). Communicate when carrying out simple, everyday tasks that require no more than simple, direct exchanges of information on familiar or routine matters. Describe in simple terms aspects of your past and surroundings, as well as issues related to your immediate needs.

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

B1 Understand the main points of clear writing in standard language when addressing familiar matters, whether for work, academic, or situations of leisure. To get by in most situations that may arise during a trip in areas where the language is used. Write simple and coherently on topics that are familiar to you or in which you have a personal interest in. Describe experiences, events, desires, and aspirations, as well as briefly explain your opinions or plans.

B2 Understand the main ideas of complex literature dealing with both specific and abstract topics, even if they are of a technical nature as long as they are within their field of specialization. Interact with native speakers with a sufficient degree of fluency and naturalness so that communication is effortless for either party. Write with clarity and in detail on diverse topics as well as defend a point of view on general topics indicating the pros and cons of different options.

ADVANCED LEVEL

C1 Understand a wide variety of lengthy literature with a certain demanding level, as well as recognize implicit meanings in them. Express yourself fluently and spontaneously without evident signs of effort to find the right expression. Make flexible and effective use of the language for social, academic, and professional purposes. Write clear, well-structured, and detailed works on topics of a certain complexity, showing proper organization, articulation, and cohesion.
